MONMOUTH DIAL-A-RIDE

WHAT IS MONMOUTH DIAL-A-RIDE?

Monmouth Dial-A-Ride is a local transport service in and around Monmouth, for people who don't have their own transport or can't use public transport due to accessibility difficulties.

We have a fully accessible mini bus equipped with a low floor capable of transporting wheelchairs and seated passengers alike.

The service is available Mondays and Thursdays, picking up between 9am and 5pm.

HOW MUCH WILL I PAY?

After the initial membership Fee, travel will be **free** for Monmouthshire concessionary Bus Pass holders. Non concessionary bus pass holders will be charged £2.50 return for journeys within a 5 mile radius of Monmouth. Further charges may apply for distances of more than 5 miles.

WHERE CAN I GO?

You'll be able to go practically anywhere in and around Monmouth, to the shops, doctors appointments, visiting friends and relatives, the library, or even the hairdressers. Anywhere you need to go, as long as you book before noon the day before your intended journey.

WHO CAN USE THE SERVICE?

- People without their own transport who also;
- Have a disability whether it's temporary or permanent
 - Use a wheelchair
 - Are elderly and/or frail

You don't have to have a physical difficulty to benefit from our service, able bodied people with no access to public transport and don't have access to a car can also use our services.

HOW DO I BOOK A SEAT?

Fill in the membership form adjacent and return to Bridges Centre, address is on the reverse of the form. You will then be given a membership number and all you will have to do is telephone **0800 085 8015** before 12 noon on Friday for Monday journeys, and before 12 noon on Wednesday for Thursday journeys. State where you want to go to, from and at what time. It's that simple!

IMPORTANT DETAILS

- If you're arranging transport for a doctors appointment, please state when booking so we can prioritize your journey
- If you can't make your journey, please let us know so someone else can travel
- Limit the amount of bags you bring with you
- Book before 12 noon one working day before your journey
